

DURABLE SOLUTIONS



Access to institutional or government protection or prevention measures:

97.7% did not access any measures


96.8% did not receive support from social organizations, international organizations, or the church.

Housing programs in hot countries:

99.7% did not access housing programs.

0.4% accessed housing programs (Peru).

Perception of security in the host country:

81.1% feel safe

Distribution by country:

Peru: 33.3% presence of criminal organizations.

22.2% housing eviction.

Ecuador:

28.2% murders, threats, intimidation or physical abuse.

15.2% presence of criminal organizations.

Colombia:

presence of criminal organizations.

18.8% murders, threats intimidation or physical abuse.
