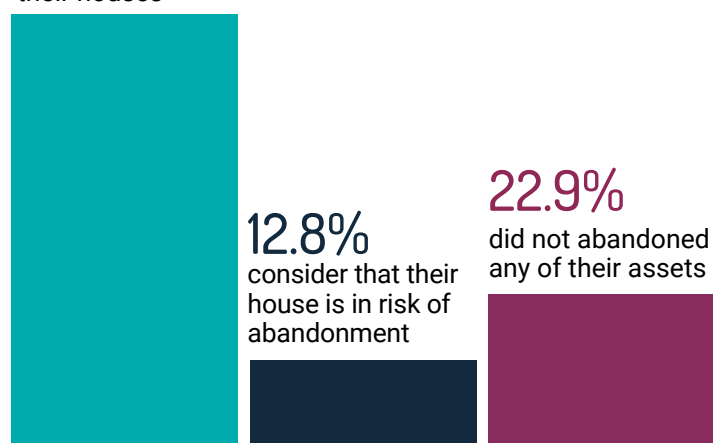

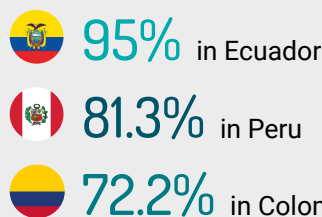
1. MAIN CHARACTERISTICS

Abandonment by host country:

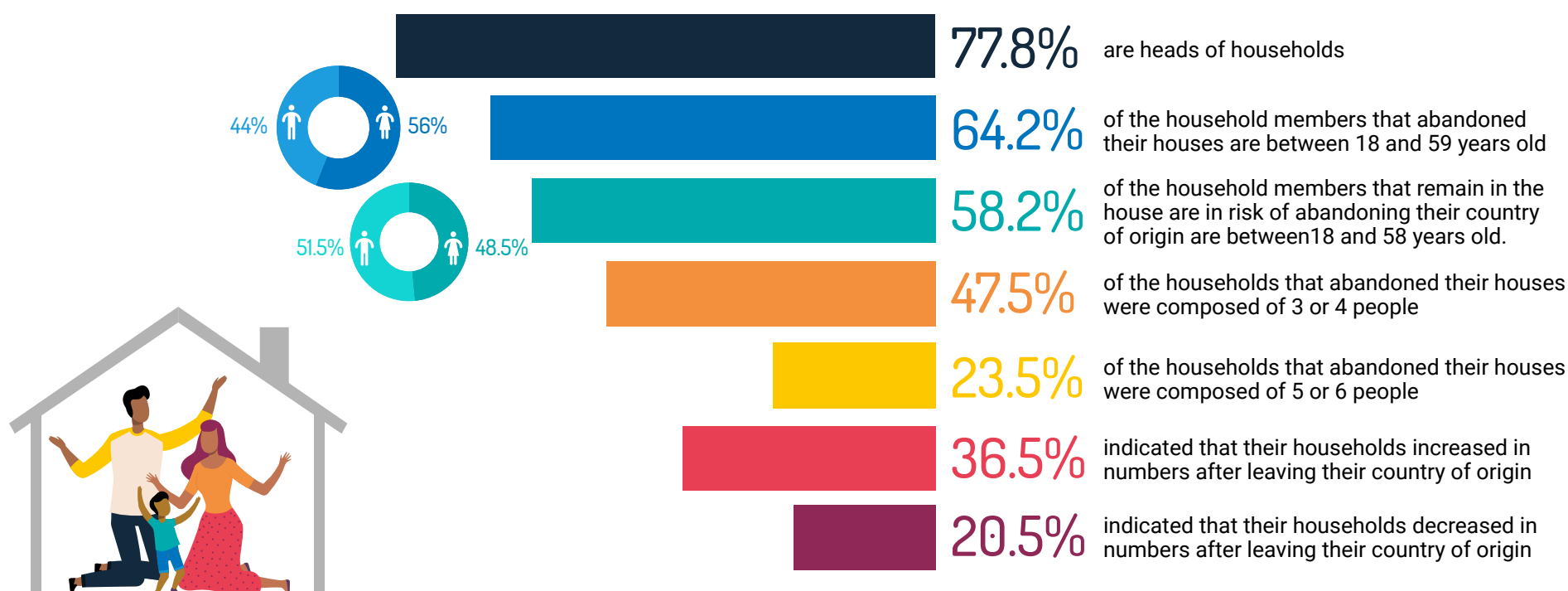


98% have shelter in host countries

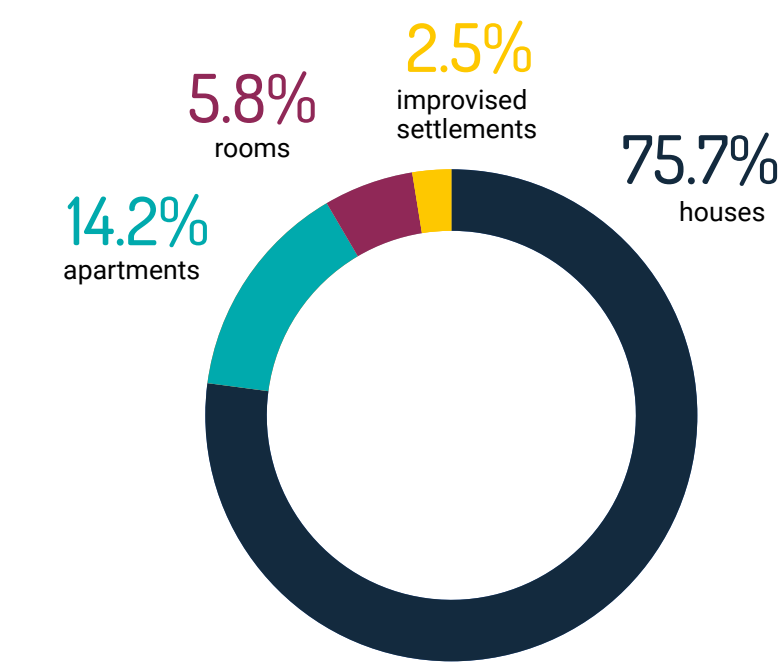
1.2% living in the streets

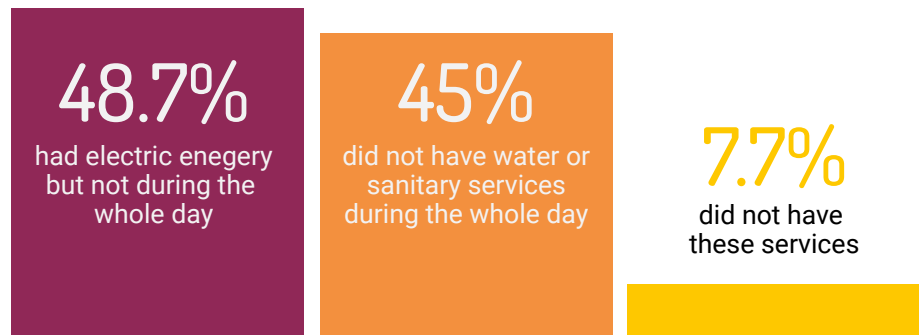


Living conditions:

40% had 1 room for 3 people

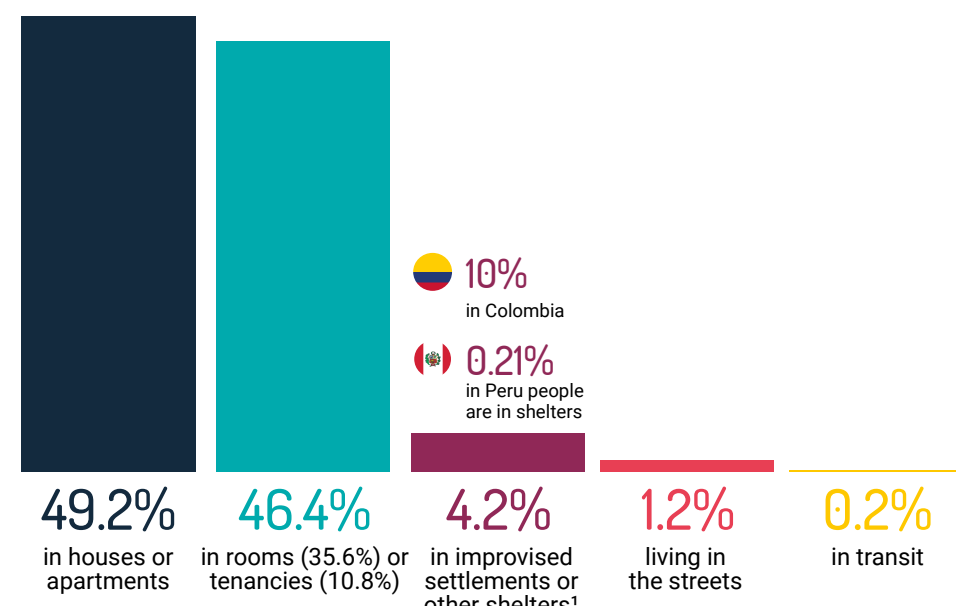
33.3% are in improvised shelters, occupied by 3 people

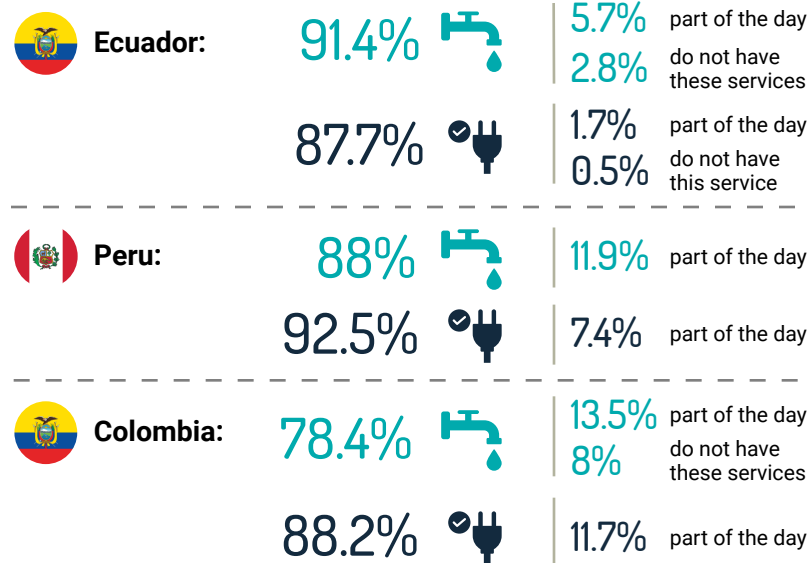

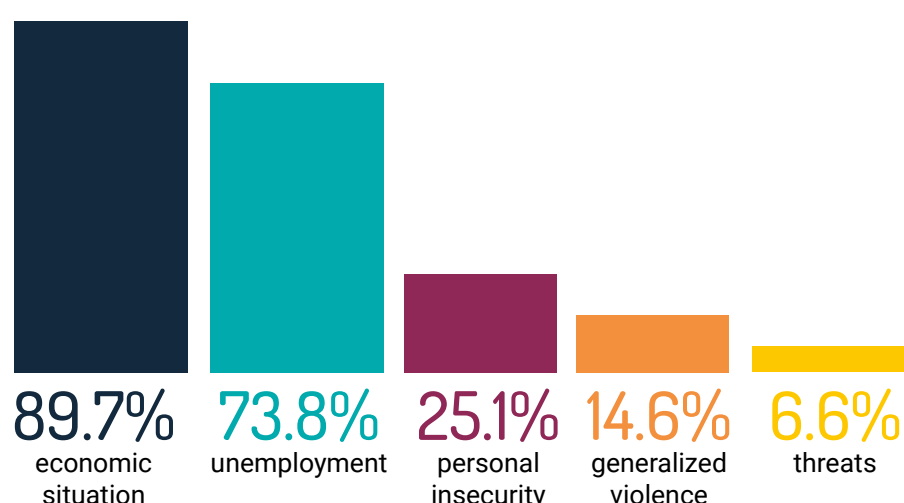
